1885/15 Planning

- (i) Demolition of attached garage/workshop construction of two storey side extension single storey rear extension and detached storage building 22 Church Street [15/00350/HHFUL]

Parish Councillors **agreed that** they have no objection in principle to the application. However, the Peterborough City Council Planning Officer is to be informed that they considered the window in the side elevation would be better situated on the rear to avoid overlooking the neighbour. The Officers are also to be mindful of the impact of the rear extension on No. 22a Church Street.
